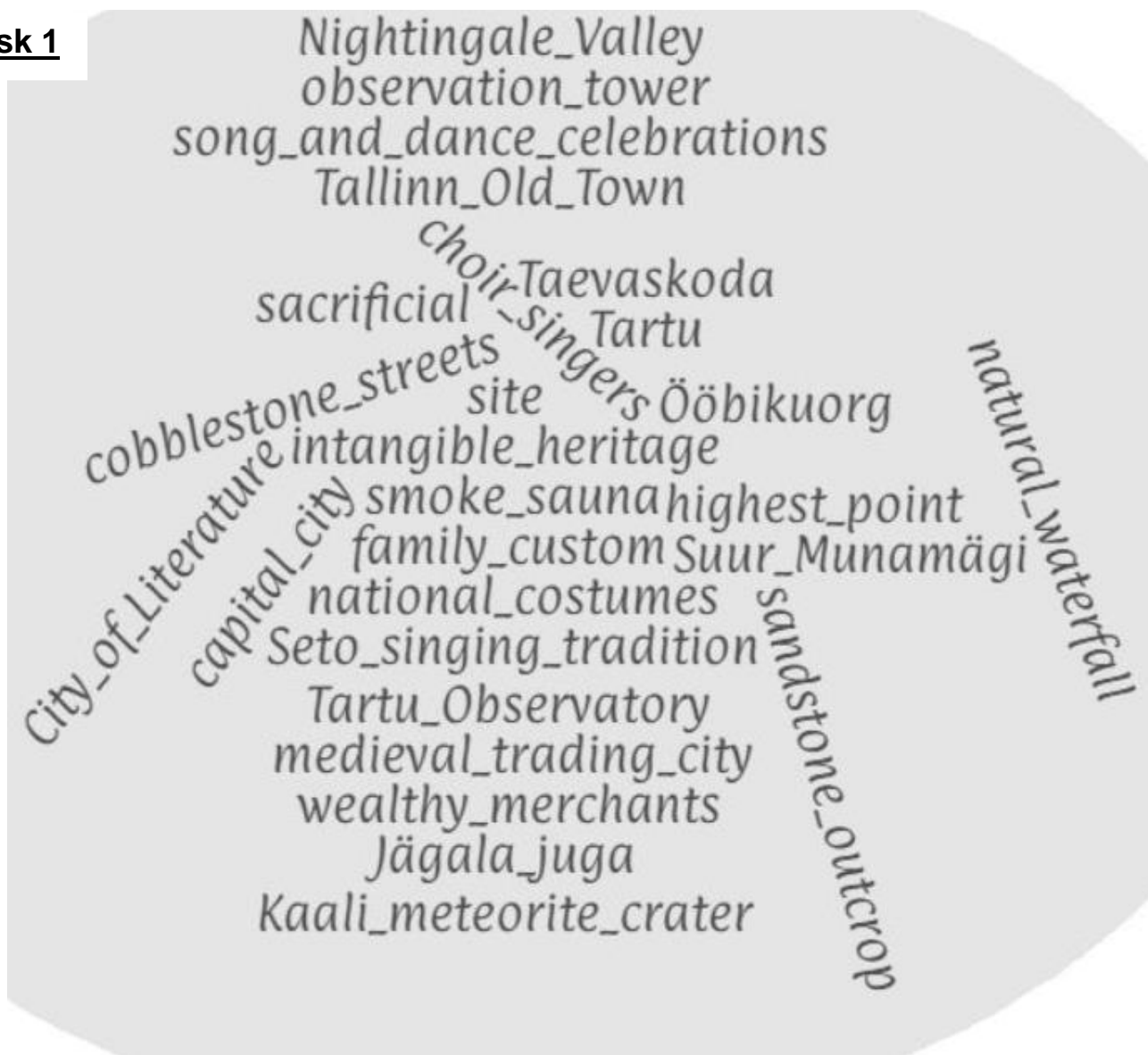

Look at the word cloud – work with a partner and sort the words into these categories:

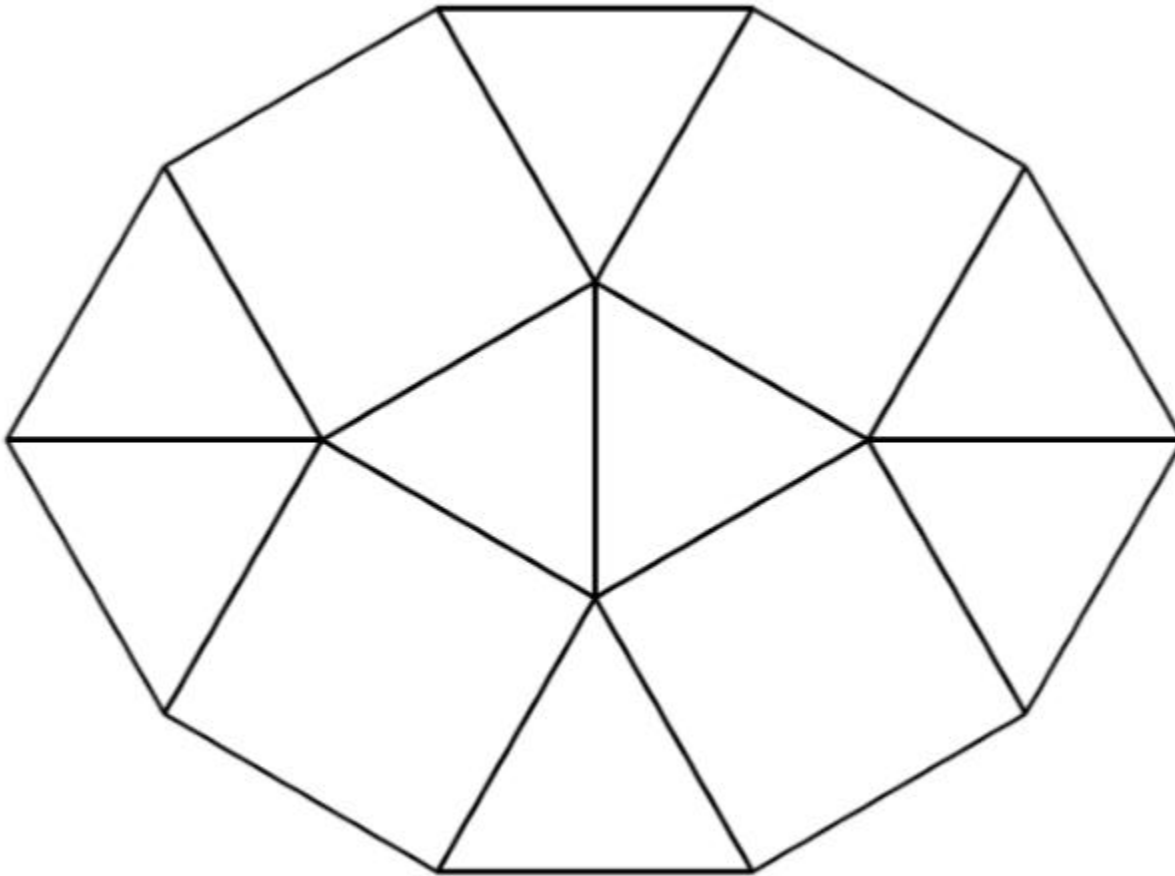
